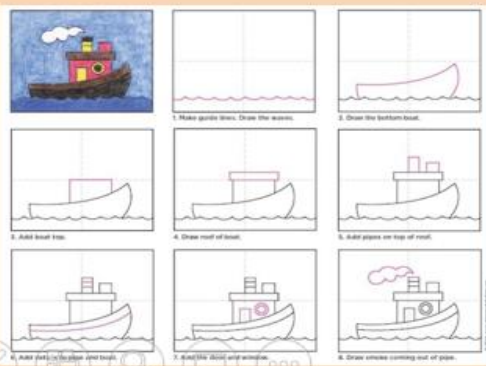


DRAWING

Michelangelo painted on the roof of the Sistine Chapel by laying on his back on a raised platform. Stick some paper under a table or a chair and give it a try!



Follow steps to draw this boat.



SCULPTURE

Bundle some sticks and twigs together. Put the bundle into a container, or bury it in the ground. What sorts of things can you decorate your tree with?



HOMEMADE PAPERCLAY

Find as much scrap paper as you can and tear it into tiny pieces. Put the paper shreds into a bowl and pour in hot water. Stir it all up until it's mushy. Pick up the mush, squeeze out as much water as you can, then spread it over the outside of a bowl. Let it dry. Peel it off and decorate.



CONSTRUCTION

Collect some straight sticks and twigs. Break them so they are all roughly the same size. Connect them with cotton thread, string, or your shoelaces! Cut or tear a piece of scrap paper or card and poke through another stick to make a sail.

WILL IT FLOAT?



What can you make out of cut, torn and twisted plastic bags?



PAINTING

Cut a **small** piece of soap off the bar in your bathroom and use it as a crayon. Draw a picture onto a scrap piece of paper or card. Press hard. Paint over the top of your picture with a wet tea bag, and it will appear!



Fill up your drink bottle and take it outside. Squeeze water slowly onto the concrete. What can you 'paint' with water before it dries?
