Literacy: Please watch the phonics videos (link below- suggested set 1&2 at least).

Writing: Imagine your own dinosaur. What would it look like? How would it sound? What would you do together if it was your pet? Finish the sentences in the picture and draw your own dinosaur!

Challenge: can you use the words 'and' or 'because' to link your sentences?

Maths: watch number blocks video- 19 (see link below). There is also a number 19 teaching PowerPoint for extra information. Can children double the amount of dots on each ladybird? (Key learning here is the idea of a double being the same amount twice). Can children add up the total? For a challenge, children can count on from the first number, e.g. starting at 8, then counting up to 16. Can children then work out what half of the number is? (The whole number split into 2). Can children write the double number sentence? E.g. $9+9=18$).

Challenge: Can children work out why you can't find a number that doubles to 19? What about 17? 15? 13? 11? Can you half these numbers evenly? Why? Why not?

Topic: Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Making relationships: What makes a good friend? What are the qualities of a good friend? How can you be a good friend? Draw a picture of a friend in the middle and write down your ideas around the edge. Can you write some of your friends' names around the edge? You could write one thing that you would like to do with your friends when we go back to school.
