Literacy: Please watch the phonics videos (link below- suggested set 1&2 at least).

Writing: Can you think of a describing word for each letter of the word 'dinosaur' to write an acrostic poem?

Challenge: Can you make the words link into a sentence?

Maths: watch number blocks video- 19 (see link below). There is also a number 19 teaching PowerPoint for extra information. Count out 19 counters (pasta, lego, etc.) Get children to close their eyes whilst adults put a pile in front of the child. Open your eyes- can you estimate how many there are? (The key here is for a roughly accurate estimation- if a child says '200' then they aren't showing that they have an accurate concept of number.) If they are struggling, you may give them a hint and say 'less than/more than...'

Challenge: can you count on to find out how many away your estimate was? (See photo for support)

Topic: Expressive art & design

Salt dough dinosaur bones! You will need:

1 cup of flour

½ cup of salt

½ cup of water

Mix these together in a bowl. When the mixture is dough like, see how many different dinosaur bones you can create! Bake in the oven on the LOWEST SETTING for 3 hours. You could paint them after, or leave them as they are. Reminder: these are NOT edible!
