Literacy: Please watch the phonics videos (link below- suggested set 1&2 at least).

Writing: Can you create a story from the story map provided? What could be happening? Look at each picture and verbally tell the story. Can you write a sentence from the story? Don't forget: capital letter, finger space, full stop! (see photo on website).

Challenge: can you write the whole story using the text map?

Maths: watch number blocks video- 18 (see link below). Line up 18 objects in a row. With your grown up, can you take some away without them looking... can they guess how many you took? Can you work out the number sentence and write it down? E.g. if you took away 6, the number sentence would be $18 - 6 = 12$. Swap over (children may struggle to work out how many there are independently here- it is a difficult skill so don't panic, adults!)

Challenge: can you try and count backwards e.g. start at 18 and count back 6... what number do you land on?

You could use a number line and try jumping back 6 places (see photo on website).

Topic: Understanding the World- people & communities With Easter coming up, it is a great time for children to talk about their own cultural and family traditions. Discuss what you do in your home that is special to your family. Do you go to a place of worship? Go swimming on a Saturday? Celebrate Easter, Eid or Diwali? Draw a picture and/or write a sentence to explain what you do together.
