Literacy: Please watch the phonics videos (link below- suggested set 1&2 at least).

Writing:

Can you write a word that rhymes with each of the words listed? How many can you write? Remember: a rhyming word has the same group of sounds at the end of each word e.g. 'cat' and 'bat' both end in 'at'! (see picture on website.)

Challenge: can I use some of these dinosaur rhyming words and write a rhyming sentence? E.g. The dinosaur has sharp claws and big jaws.

Maths: watch number blocks video- 18 (see link below). How many different addition number sentences can you make with objects? Can you draw these number sentences? Can you write these number sentences underneath? (see photo on website).

Challenge: can you count on from one group to the next? E.g. instead of counting two groups of objects starting at 1 and counting them all, try starting at the total number in one group. (photo on website for guidance)

Topic: RE

Children have learned the Easter story up until Jesus prayed in the garden of Gethsemane. Watch the video (link on website) and discuss what happens next in the story, where Jesus is crucified. Can children explain why he was crucified? (No need to talk about rising from the dead- that is a separate lesson!)
