	Answers should refer to what the child thinks Tricky feels and should explain why they think it.	2	<b>Content domain:</b> 1d - Make inferences from the text. <b>Award 2 marks</b> for an answer that explains what the child thinks Tricky is feeling and explains their reasons for thinking it. <b>Award 1 mark</b> for an answer that explains what the child thinks Tricky is feeling but does not explain why. <b>Do not accept answers</b> that clearly do not relate to the events of the story.
