# Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> May- Create a story...

## Plan

**Opening:** Setting- where does your story take place?  
Who are the characters in your story? How did she find the egg?  
Why did she leave the village?

Add lots of description- describe the egg, Zoya, the setting...  
describe everything!

**Build up:** How did Zoya take care of the egg? What did she  
have to do? How did she help it to grow up like a dragon?

**Problem:** Who is in trouble? Zoya/ the dragon/ the village/  
Zoya's family/ is there a new and dangerous dragon in the area?  
How are they in trouble?

**Resolution:** How did Zoya and the dragon solve the problem?  
What did they do?

**Ending:** Will the dragon continue to live with Zoya?  
Did the dragon survive the problem?

# Friday 8th May- Create a story...

## **Write your story!**

Use the plan from yesterday to write your story.

Story starter:

When the dragon had hatched, crawling out of it's shell onto her bed, Zoya knew that her life would never be the same again.
