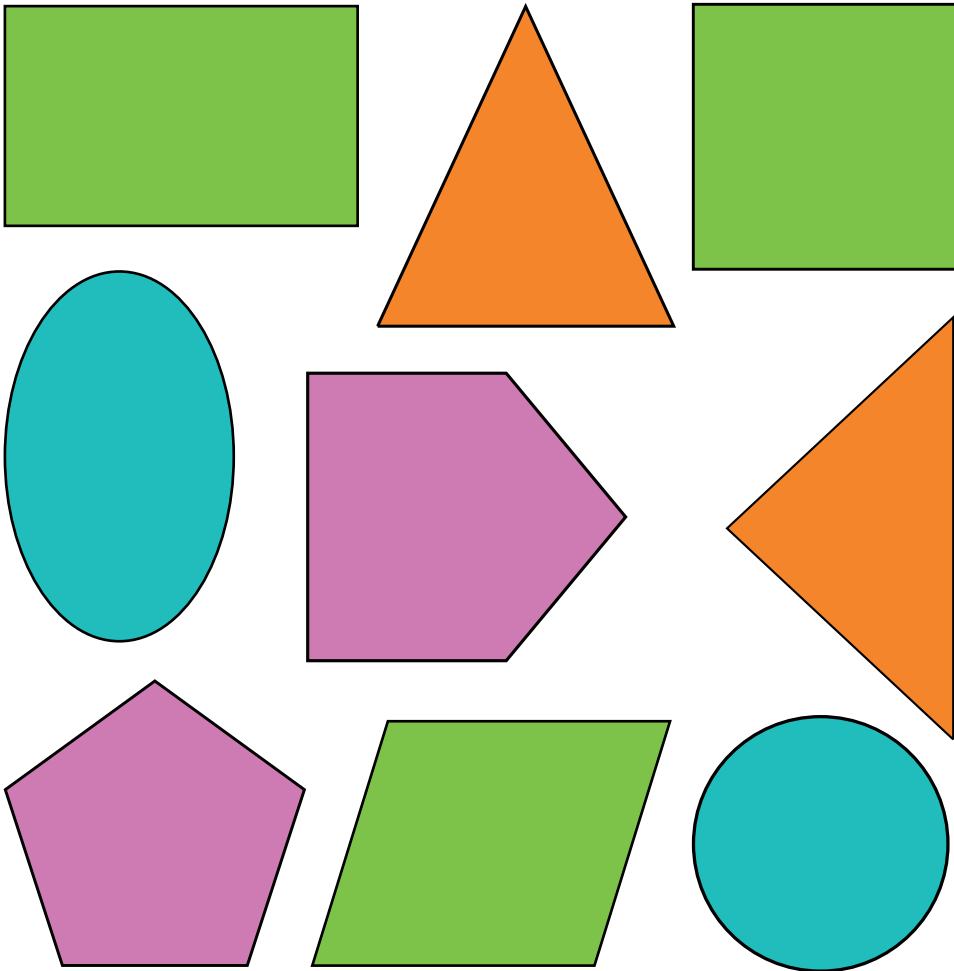




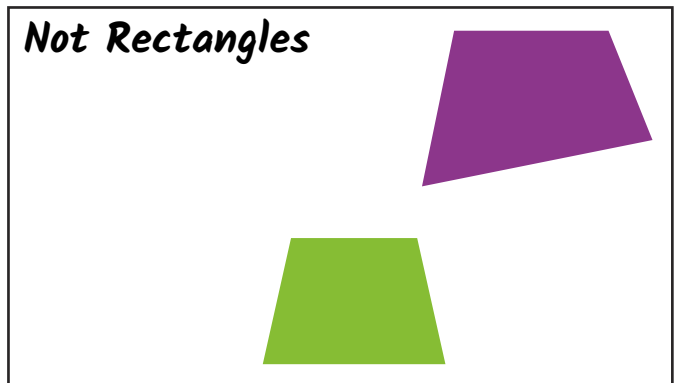
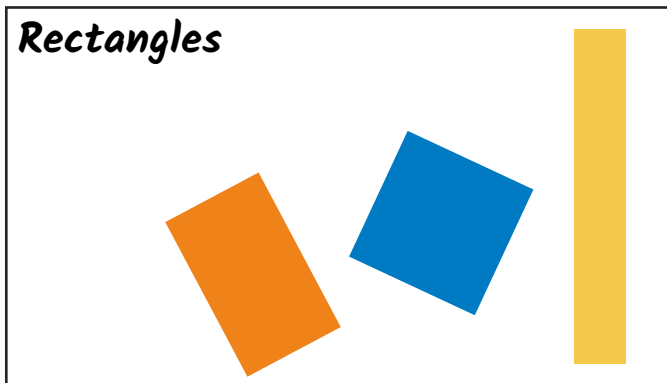
- 1 side

*Evan is incorrect. A circle has one curved side.*



*There are three rectangles in the groups of quadrilaterals, including the square. The other shapes are not rectangles because they don't have pairs of opposite sides of equal lengths.*





*A circle cannot be made with straight sides.*

*A two sided shape cannot be made from two straight sides.*

*Children can make different sizes of squares and rectangles. They may also be able to make other quadrilaterals that they cannot name.*

*They experiment with other shapes they can make including one with ten sides.*
