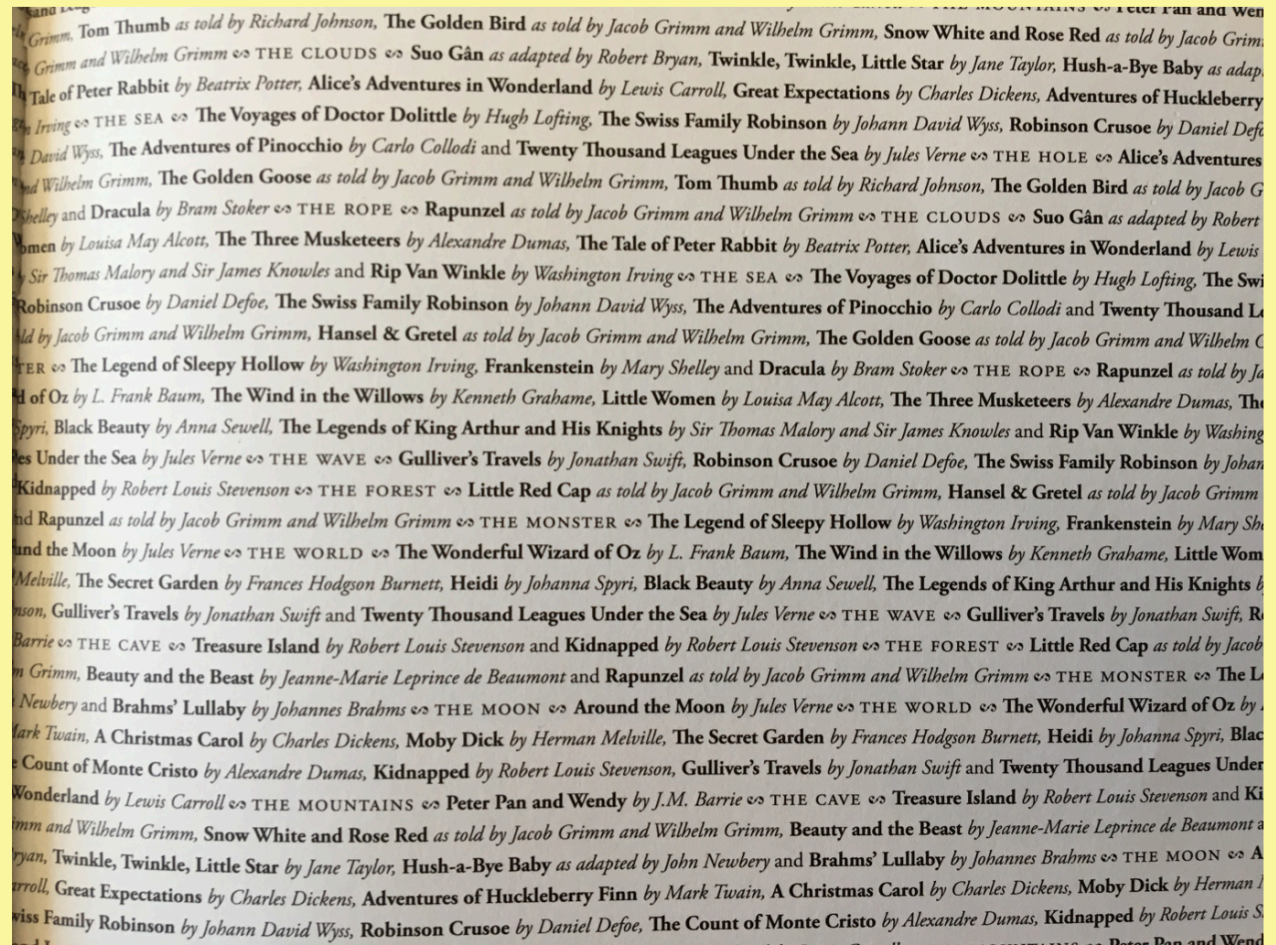


Activity 1 - Endpapers

Endpapers are the pages you see first when you open a book (on the under side of the front cover). In 'A Child of Books', this page on the right is the endpaper.

In the video, I asked you to pause at this picture and see what words you recognised. I recognised *Hansel & Gretel*; I know *Hansel & Gretel* is a fairytale.

Have a look again at this picture and see how many words you recognise! Where do you recognise them from? What are they types of?



Activity 2 – Character Moods

How can you tell how a person is feeling and what they are thinking? In picturebooks, you can tell by a character's facial expressions.

Have a look at some of the pictures on the next slide (they are in order of when they appear in the book) and answer the questions below.

1. *What emotions do you think the boy is feeling at the start of the book?*
2. *Do these emotions change as he embarks on the journey with the girl?*
3. *What does his facial expression suggest he feels at the end of the book?*

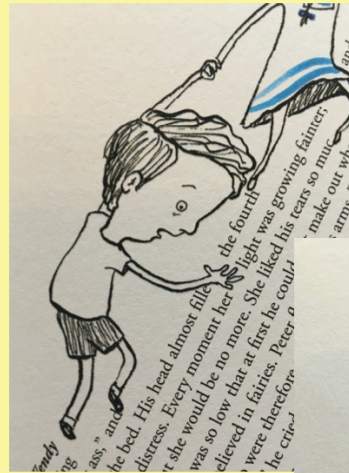
