LO: to answer different types of questions

Type of Questions

There are many different types of questions. Let's focus on these three:

A pink, cloud-shaped graphic with a black outline, containing text.

JUSTIFICATION – *Can you explain why?*

EVALUATE – *Why do you like?*

LITERAL – *What are they doing?*

Activity 1:

Recap... Let's reread the last page of chapter 6:

She turned to face him.

'It's just – ' Now, tipping her head to one side, she looked him very closely in the eye. 'It's just – '
'*What?*'

Kirsty shook her head, sighing.

'It's just that somehow you seem *different* today. I can't think what it is about you that's odd.
But you're not *you*.'

She turned to go.

Bill reached out to try and stop her.

'But who am I?' he asked her desperately.

'Who *am* I?'

But Kirsty, the fastest runner in the class, had sped away.

Questions

1. Kirsty's body language is described on the last page of chapter 6. What four body movements does she make? For example, Kirsty's first body language description is, she turned to face Paul. What are the other three? (**LITERAL**)
2. Why does Kirsty think Bill is acting differently? (**EVALUATE**)
3. Bill seems frustrated at Kirsty's comments. Why do you think that is? (**JUSTIFICATION**)
