Spelling: We have covered all tricky words now, so we are going focus on common exception words and weekly spelling.

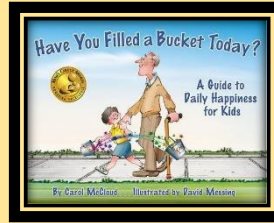
